The Board voted unanimously on the following: "It is the findings of the Biggs Unified School Board that sufficient evidence has been presented that warrant student 2022-23#2 be expelled from the Biggs Unified School District for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. The Board is suspending the expulsion and is instructing the superintendent to allow the student to attend Independent Study for the fall semester. Upon completing a rehabilitation plan she then may be considered eligible for reenrollment for the spring semester at Biggs High School. This is the Board's finding."

The District will be in contact with the parent within ten (10) days to explain their rights and they can make a decision on where they want to go from there.
