

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

## Question: My dentist is no longer a Delta Dental network provider...now what?

Answer: The good news...BSSP's dental plans provide coverage for non-network providers so you can continue to receive treatment from your dentist.

The not-so-good-news...you may have an additional financial responsibility when receiving services from an out-of-network provider. Here are some things to consider:

- Out-of-network dentists may bill the difference between their usual fee and Delta Dental's contracted rate a process known as "balance billing."
- Out-of-network dentists may also require you to pay the full cost of treatment up front. You can then submit your claim for reimbursement using the <u>Dental Claim Form</u>.

## Question: What are the benefits of seeing an in-network provider?

- Answer: Here are six great reasons to see an in-network provider:
  - 1. <u>Greater savings.</u> In-network dentists have agreed to reduced fees, which leaves more money in your pocket.
  - 2. <u>Quality assurance.</u> Make sure your smile gets the care it deserves. Delta Dental monitors in-network dentists to ensure proper licensing, cleanliness and safety procedures.
  - 3. <u>No balance billing</u>. In-network dentists can't charge you more than their set fees.
  - 4. <u>Avoid unbundling.</u> In-Network dentists agree not to "unbundle" services that are part of a treatment, like tooth preparation or local anesthesia. Out-of-network dentists may charge for these services separately, making overall costs higher.
  - 5. <u>Less paperwork.</u> In-network dentists handle all claim forms and other paperwork for you. If you choose an out-of-network dentist, you may need to submit a claim yourself.
  - 6. <u>No prepayment required.</u> When you choose an in-network dentist, you'll pay only your portion of the bill. Delta Dental will pay their share directly to your dentist.
