<u>Position</u> Description:	Organize, supervise, and implement a total interscholastic volleyball program for students and assume the head coaching duties of the Junior Varsity team. Work with the Head Varsity Coach to implement a total volleyball program.
<u>Job Goal</u> :	To help each participating student achieve a high level of skill, and appreciation for the values of discipline and sportsmanship, and an increased level of self-esteem.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. <u>Personal Qualities</u>: Maintain a neat and clean appearance; meet District standards for physical and mental health; demonstrate enthusiasm towards coaching assignment; demonstrate ability to maintain cooperative relations with others, model characteristics desired for sportsmanlike conduct.
- 2. <u>Professional Recommendations</u>: Better than average recommendations from supervisors, from professionals who have observed and evaluated the personal characteristics, scholastic attainment, classroom performance, and coaching expertise of the candidate.
- 3. <u>Experience</u>: One year assisting varsity coach or 2 years coaching volleyball or 3 years of volleyball background.
- 4. Must have/obtain valid: First Aid and CPR cards, or EMT I or II card, or Trainer's Certification prior to employment <u>and must meet Athletic Team Coach Qualifications and competencies as required by the California Code of Regulations 5593 (Title 5), current TB and fingerprint clearances, and Biggs Unified School District policy.</u>
- 5. Must have current California Driver license and adequate transportation to perform duties.

Definition (Title 5): All coaches must have:

- 1. Knowledge and competence in care and prevention of athletic injuries, basic first aid and emergency.
- 2. Knowledge of coaching techniques.
- 3. Knowledge of rules and regulations in the athletic activity being coached.
- 4. Training in child or adolescent psychology whichever is appropriate to the grade level of the involved sports activity; such as prior active involvement with youth in a school or community sports program.

Performance Responsibilities:

- 1. Establish standards, oversee conduct, and monitor student progress for the entire district volleyball program.
- 2. Coach individual participants in the skills necessary for excellent achievement in the sport involved under the supervision of the Administrator in charge of athletics.

- 3. Maintain necessary attendance forms, insurance records, and similar paperwork.
- 4. Oversee the safety conditions of the facility or area in which assigned sport is conducted at all times that students are present.
- 5. Establish and enforce performance criteria for eligibility in interscholastic competition in his/her sport.
- 6. Enforce discipline and sportsmanlike behavior at all times, and establish and oversee penalties for breach of such standards by individual students as directed by the Administrator in charge of athletics.
- 7. Plan and schedule a regular program of practice in season as assigned by the Administrator in charge of athletics.
- 8. Work closely with the Athletic Director and/or head varsity coach in scheduling intramural and interscholastic contest as assigned by the Administrator in charge of athletics.
- 9. Recommend purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms as assigned by the Administrator in charge of athletics.
- 10. Attend and/or participate in District-sponsored or other approved activities, clinics, or training related to the sport.

Evaluation:

The Administrator in charge of athletics will evaluate performance.
